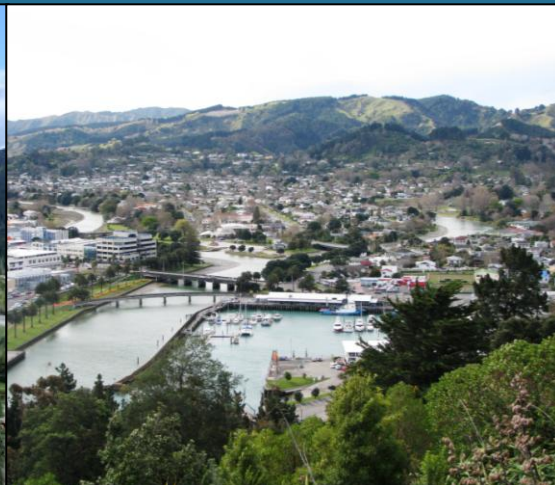

CONFERENCE PROGRAMME

Below is a brief description of the conference programme outlining some of the presentation topics and fieldtrip locations. A more detailed conference programme including speakers, topics and timeframes will be released in the August addition of the NZARM broadsheet.

Tuesday 8th Oct

Presentations, Day One

Gisborne Conference Centre

Presentations will be held around the following areas:

- **Soil Conservation**
- **Land use**
- **Water Resources – water plans, irrigation etc**
- **Cultural aspects of Resource Management**
- **Biodiversity**
- **Nutrient Management**
- **Farm Planning**

Wednesday 9th Oct

Field Trip, Day Two

Whatatutu and Mangatu

- **Poverty Bay Flats** – Gisborne's principal alluvial plain used for intensive landuses
- **Mangatu Blocks Inc** – A large incorporation established to facilitate and promote the use and administration of Māori freehold land on behalf of its owners. The incorporation manages several large blocks of land under a commercial land management structure.
- **Mangatu forest** – A major commercial forest established on Mangatu land that is crown owned.
- **Waipaoa Station** – A commercial sheep and beef farm that also runs the Waipaoa Farm Cadet Training Trust based at Whatatutu
- **Tarndale Slip** – A massive slip covering at least 40ha. This slip in Mangatu played its part in contributing to the afforestation of the Mangatu forest as a way of preventing further occurrences.
- **Forest Harvesting** – on soft rocks

Thursday 10th Oct

Field Trip, Day Three

East Coast

- **Titirangi Hill** – also known as Kaiti Hill which refers to the first ridge overlooking Gisborne City and the Port and is also the landing place of Captain Cook.
- **Tolaga Bay** – A small town on the East Coast located 45 minutes north of Gisborne, home to the longest wharf in New Zealand
- **Mangaroa Station** – 806ha of challenging East Coast hill country southwest of Tokomaru Bay, a property many people may consider only suitable for forestry with around 58,000 poplar and willow poles planted to help with slope stabilisation and to act as “living hay barns” to feed stock.
- **Waiomoko Valley** – 1980s Catchment Control Scheme
- **Steepland Forest Harvesting**

*Note: Fieldtrip locations may be subject to change

Friday 11th October – Post Conference Field Trip

We hope to be able to organise a Post Conference Field Trip to the East Coast to look at sites that the buses cannot otherwise get to (additional cost will apply). As numbers are strictly limited (approximately 15), we would appreciate it if you would indicate on the Registration form whether you are interested in coming on this fieldtrip. We will provide further information as it comes to hand, with expected costs, etc.



Registration Information

Registration for the conference is to be received by **1st September 2013**. A late registration fee of \$70 will be applicable to registrations after that date. Registrations close **20th September 2013**. Registering and booking flights early will save on costs towards attending the conference.

Accommodation

Some accommodation options are included in the Registration Pack. We have been able to negotiate reduced rates with several facilities within walking distance of the conference venue. Otherwise there is a wide range of alternative accommodation options available within close proximity to the conference venue.

Location

The Gisborne Conference Centre is located on Level 1 of The Marinaview Building, 6 Reads Quay, with easy walking and wheelchair access to all facilities. The field trip is more suited to delegates with a reasonable level of fitness. However, delegates with limited mobility are welcome and will be catered for accordingly. Please inform us of any needs at the time of conference registration.

Cancellation

The NZARM Conference Committee reserves the right to cancel the Conference due to unforeseen circumstances. In this unlikely event, a full refund will be returned to registered delegates, who will be contacted directly.

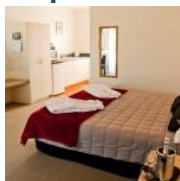

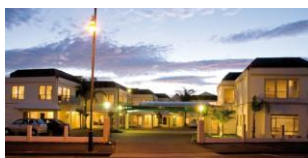
