Dr William Rolleston is a South Canterbury farmer and founding shareholder and director of South Pacific Sera. A former South Canterbury provincial president, Dr Rolleston is on the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment's Science Committee.

Alison trained at Massey and practised as a large animal veterinarian throughout the Waikato, Taranaki and Bay of Plenty and worked in a flying vet practice in Queensland.

She has dairy farmed in both NZ and Australia for 25 years. While farming in Australia with her family, she assisted in the design and implementation of the "On Farm Quality Assurance Schemes" for Nestle, and then managed the establishment of Intelact Agribusiness Consultancy in Australia before joining Commonwealth Bank of Australia in 2007.

Since returning to NZ at the end of 2009, Alison has undertaken post graduate study in freshwater ecology, policy and nutrient management in agriculture and has been an expert witness for a number of regional plan changes across NZ.

Alison is lead consultant for Headlands, a new and growing agribusiness consultancy that specialises in helping farmers design their farm systems with the future in mind: (optimal profit, minimal footprint).

Rod Oram is an inspiring and well researched journalist/speaker on corporate, economic and political issues - he's a regular broadcaster on radio and television; a columnist for the Sunday Star Times and has contributed to several regional economic development projects.
