


User Guide - How to use the Capability Assessment Tool (CAT)

Take the Assessment


- 1. Search 'New Zealand Association of Resource Management' on your web browser.
- 2. Scroll down the home page and click on the button 'Take the Assessment.'



Create your Login

1. **Scroll** down the webpage and **click** 'Create your Login here.'

Note: The Capability Assessment Tool webpage contains all the background information on the CAT and how you will be able to use it.




Sign up to NZARM

Note: If you don't have an existing NZARM login, you will need to sign up to become an NZARM member and access the CAT






NZARM Membership

Note: NZARM membership is FREE until 2025, as long as you complete the CAT.






Resource Management Experience


1. **Fill in** and provide a brief outline of your experience, interest or involvement in Resource Management.

NOTE - The NZARM executive will evaluate your membership and either approve or request further information from you via email.




Sign Up Process Complete

1. To complete the CAT, **click** on '<u>Update your career</u> info' on the NZARM member dashboard.




NOTE - Your details will have been carried over from when you signed up to join NZARM.

1. Click on each of the drops-downs and select your answers to the following questions.




Quick Tips:

Priority Learning Areas


- 1. Please **select** your top three priority learning areas for your career development.

1. Fill in the remaining questions across the 12 different competencies to assess your level of experience and knowledge by **clicking** on the drop-down arrows.

NOTE - For your Capability Profile to load, you <u>must</u> answer each question.



Competency Assessment

1. For each topic area, you will be asked to indicate your level of knowledge and experience across the relevant statements. Please select the answer that you believe represents your understanding the best.

2. Once complete, click 'Back to Dashboard Summary'.



To **describe** means to provide a detailed account or representation of something, often focusing on its characteristics, features, or qualities.

To **explain** involves clarifying the underlying principles, reasons, or mechanisms behind a concept or process.


To **practically apply** means to put knowledge, skills, or principles into practice in a specific context or situation.

To **confidently teach** means to convey knowledge, skills, or concepts to others with self-assurance, clarity, and competence.

Viewing your Capability Profile


You have now completed the Capability Assessment Tool.

Navigating your Capability Profile

Once you have completed your assessment, all of the data is compiled into your Capability Profile. Based on the information you have provided, your profile will display your image, job title, highest level of education, and profile.





Navigating your Capability Profile

On the left-hand side of the dashboard is the sunburst diagram that demonstrates your calculated capability across the 12 capability areas. The sunburst diagram is interactive, drag your mouse out from the centre to zoom in.

The capability rays are calculated and weighted based on formal training, work experience and self-

The right-hand side portrays all the regions where you work.





Navigating your Capability Profile

Scroll down the page to view the achievement badges; these represent the formal qualification you selected earlier in the assessment.

Once you have reviewed your capability assessment, you can print and save a PDF of the dashboard, allowing you to timestamp your current capability and share it with others.
